

Kindergarten Screening

The Kindergarten screening will test your child's ability to:

- 1. Sit down and follow directions when asked
- 2. Sit and read with the teacher when asked
 - a. Understand how to orient a picture book
 - b. Listen to a storybook from beginning to end
- 3. Recognize their first and last name within a list of words
- 4. Write their name with a pencil on paper
- 5. Identify basic shapes and colors
- 6. Identify uppercase and lowercase letters
- 7. Produce letter sounds when shown a letter
- 8. Count as high as they can with the objective being to count up to 20
- 9. Identify numbers from 1-20
- 10. Display from 1-10 fingers (When asked to hold up six fingers, child can show the teacher six fingers)
- 11. Count a number of objects (When given a handful of less than ten objects, the child can count and tell the teacher how many they have)
